Incentives:

Please be advised that Yara has offered incentives for our craft workers during the fall T/A to optimize the attaction and retention of the required work force. The incentives listed below will take effect for the turn-around starting on September 9, 2024 and go until the turn-around comes to a successful completion which is expected on September 25, 2024. The incentives will not take effect for Pre or Post outage work. The client remains dedicated to incentivizing the turn-around but reserves the right to cancel any incentives over and above the collective agreement (GPMA) at its sole descretion. Incentives:

- 1. Work schedule is expected to be 12 hours per day on a 13-1 schedule with the base schedule of a CWW of 4-10's with all overtime at double time. This reflects 10 hours of straight time pay for the first 10 hours Monday through Thursday and 2 hours of double time. There will be an additional ½ hour at straight time pay plus a \$30 meal allowance for meal break. The 12 hours worked on Friday through Sunday will all be at double time. The workforce will be paid 12.5 hours for a workday of 12 hours.
- 2. Local personnel will be paid \$30/day travel for each full day worked.
- 3. Workers living outside a 100km radius will be paid \$165 LOA at 7 days per week during the outage window. (proper documentation verifying residence may be requested).
